

History

The Newtown Square Business and Professional Association was formed in May of 1976 by a group of local business people who recognized the need for coordinated action on behalf of the business community. The organization is governed by the Constitution and By-Laws created in 1976, and officers are elected annually from the membership at large. NSB&PA is incorporated within the State of Pennsylvania and has a non-profit status.

Purpose

To act in the best interests of all members and to engage in such activities that would lead to the improvement and encouragement of doing business in Newtown Square, and to work in conjunction with the Township Supervisors to solve mutual problems.

Meetings / Dues

Breakfast or luncheon meetings are seven times a year, normally on the second Thursday of each month at pre-announced locations. These meetings are informal, and open to anyone doing business within Newtown Township. Speakers of interest to the business community are generally provided.

Membership dues, as established by membership vote, are currently \$70.00 per year per business. One membership fee covers all employees of the member business.

Activities

The majority of our activities are directed toward continued improvement within the business community for the benefit of members as well as their customers. With the cooperation of the Township Supervisors, numerous NSB&PA committees have been active in areas of common concern such as the sign ordinance, township fiscal policies and Christmas lighting and banners. The NSB&PA also sponsors fundraising events within the community as well as social events for members and guests.

Membership

Membership in the NSB&PA is open to any person or organization doing business within Newtown Township. In addition to having a single voice to speak for all Newtown Square businesses, membership in the NSB&PA offers these other individual benefits.

- Significant input with the township government on matters concerning the business community.
- "Business Alert" notices issued to members warning of bad check passers and con games in the area.
- Annual Scholarship Award to Marple-Newtown Student.
- Improved public relations between the public and the business community.
- Coordinated promotions to encourage residents to shop locally.
- Sponsorship of community projects such as providing Christmas lighting and banners for the business district.
- Luncheons and breakfasts enabling members to compare problems and solutions.
- Monthly newsletter to keep you abreast of items affecting your business.
- Social functions for members and their guests.

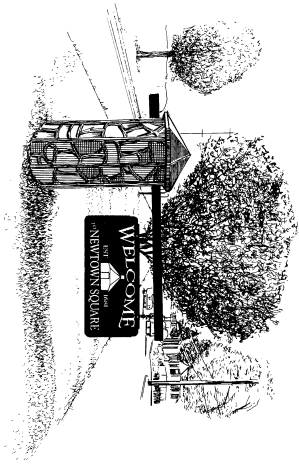
